Sermon Notes

Grace Glossary:

Faith as a noun is the content of the truth God has revealed to us, which would otherwise be unknowable. *Faith* as a verb is the act of believing what God has revealed, and is the relationship to Him and His word that He approves. Faith is characterized in such attitudes as trust, dependence, and confidence, issuing in obedience.

Righteous consists in all that is in accord with God's nature and word, both in His own acts and in all He requires of us.

Salvation means "deliverance," as in all God has promised us in Christ rescuing us from evil and its consequences, and restoring us to His eternal glory.
